

Policy Statement

The library strives to create opportunities for its community to utilize emerging technologies. This policy was created to establish under what circumstances and how customers can use the library's 3D printer.

Regulations

1. The 3D printer shall only be used for lawful purposes. The 3D printer shall not be used to print any of the following:
 - A. Items prohibited by local, state or federal law.
 - B. Items deemed unsafe, harmful, dangerous or otherwise pose a threat to others, such as weapons.
 - C. Items that are obscene or otherwise inappropriate as deemed by library staff.
 - D. Items in violation of another's intellectual property rights, including copyright, patent, or trademark. Responsibility for copyright or any other intellectual property infringement lies solely with the user; the library disclaims any responsibility or liability resulting therefrom.
2. The library reserves the right to refuse any 3D print request.
3. The library is not responsible for any damage, loss, functionality or quality of content produced by the 3D printer.
4. Only designated library staff or volunteers shall have "hands on" access to the 3D printer.
