Policy Statement

The Clinton-Macomb Public Library (CMPL) provides the Donald W. Green Local History Room for research and preservation of local history.

Regulations

- 1. The Donald W. Green Local History Room, equipment and furnishings will be used exclusively for the purpose of local history research and related activities.
- 2. The room may be reserved by local history organizations that comply with the library's Meeting Room Use policy.
- 3. A key may be obtained at the Adult Nonfiction Desk by anyone with a valid resident or guest library card in good standing. Visitors may provide a drivers license in exchange for a key.
- 4. Some materials are locked at all times and may require assistance from a staff member for access.
- 5. Food or drinks will not be permitted in the Donald W. Green Local History Room.
- 6. Gloves should be used when using fragile materials and are available at the Adult Nonfiction Desk.
- 7. Taping, stapling or tacking of materials to the walls or other furnishings is prohibited.
